

**TAKE CHARGE  
OF YOUR LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT MEETINGS**

What does it mean to "take charge" when you're watching the founding principles of America **come under attack day after day**? When it's happening in the media, in your local ordinances, and even in your child's classroom at school?

Taking charge requires each individual to step out of passivity and become an active member of their community. One of the best ways **YOU** can do that and have an immediate effect is by getting involved and making yourself heard at local government meetings.

**Here's how to do it.**

**1 FIND YOUR NEXT MEETING**

To start, do your research. Generally, there are laws requiring a public notice for each meeting and a process to provide public comment. A good starting point is checking the website for the **school board, city council, or county board**. Look for the meeting notice, public comment process, and main contact person for the meeting. You may even be able to sign-up for email updates regarding future meetings. If you have any questions about the process, contact the person listed on the meeting notice. Many public meetings are recorded and you are able to watch previous meetings online. To help you feel more comfortable, it may be helpful to take some time to watch the public comment portion of the meeting before attending.

Some meetings are conducted by Zoom or another online method. The process to join the meeting and share public comments should be available by the board or council.

Many times a written record is maintained for the public meeting. Come prepared with written copies of your comments or ask the meeting contact about emailing the comments for inclusion in the meeting record.

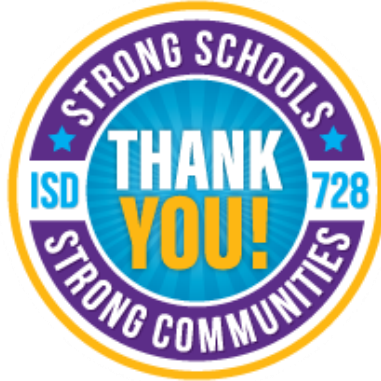
